To educate students on the importance of soft skills in the workplace. To dispel common myths associated with language and communication skills.

Event Description:

On 20th July 2020, ASMA organized a guest lecture on "Busting Myths: Uncovering the Reality behind Myths" for MBA students. The session was conducted by Mrs. Amrita Lobo in the ASMA Hall.

Mrs. Amrita Lobo emphasized the critical importance of language and communication skills, highlighting that these skills are equally crucial, if not more so, for success in the workplace. She explained how soft skills complement technical skills and contribute significantly to effective communication, collaboration, and overall job performance.

During her lecture, Mrs. Lobo addressed several myths related to soft skills:

She countered the belief that soft skills are innate and cannot be developed, stating that while some individuals may possess them naturally, and these skills can be honed and improved over time. She dispelled the myth that soft skills are only important for entry-level positions, asserting that they are essential at all career levels.

Mrs. Lobo also discussed the misconception that soft skills are not measurable or quantifiable, emphasizing that their impact on job performance can be significant and oNSErvable. She highlighted that soft skills are just as important as technical skills, if not more, in certain contexts.

Lastly, she clarified that soft skills are relevant across all industries, not just specific ones.






